**About NSS:**

Rayburn College, Churachandpur had been participating in the scheme from the year 2007. The service has been established with a fundamental aim to create social consciousness, sense of responsibility and personality development among the students through involvement in social work and community service. From the date of its inception, volunteers and Programme Officers of this unit have been already rendering their voluntary services for the expansion of NSS activities in taking up various programmes. Presently Rayburn college has two units- Unit I and Unit II, and the units have been looked after by two Program Officers' Shri Lt. Suan L. Hauzel and Ms Mercy Chingnunhoih of Psychology Department. As per the NSS guidelines, various programmes have been under taken up under Regular and Special camping programmes.

The two units has 3 Adopted villages namely:

1. Mata
  2. Tangnuam
  3. Mission Compound
- NSS Activities

2020-2021 was a challenging year for the whole world & also for the NSS Unit of Rayburn College. The units have not been able to conduct much activities due to the pandemic and the shifting of

college campus to new campus. However, they tried their best to perform and conduct activities as much as possible amidst the pandemic situation. The following are the brief reports of the few physical activities of the NSS Units: -

➤ **Mass Cleaning and Social work:**

As the college was shifted to new campus, the NSS in collaboration with the administration team organized a cleanliness campaign followed by mass cleaning and social work during 22.09.2020 and 10.10.2020, in and around the newly constructed college campus. All Programme Officers, staffs and 45 volunteers took part in this event.

➤ **Orientation and Enrolment program:**

Orientation and Enrolment program regarding the service, volunteers' responsibilities and works were held at every new Academic session. For the academic session 2021-22, enrolment drive was conducted during the month of April and as many as 200 new volunteers enrolled for both the units.

➤ **Covid-19 Mass Awareness Campaign- Vaccination Mahotsav:**

72 volunteers of our college with both the POs conducted Covid-19 Mass awareness campaign on the theme "Unite to Fight Corona", during 11<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2021. The volunteers participated in mass awareness vaccination mahotsav campaign to register and vaccinated people above 45 years of age. The NSS volunteers also distributed face masks to local vendors and making local community aware to keep safe from Covid19.

➤ **Medical camp:**

The NSS unit organized One day Medical camp for Rayburn College Staff in collaboration with CMO, Churachandpur on April, 5, 2021. The main purpose is to provide the staffs of Rayburn college with free medical consultation, information regarding diet and exercise, full body checkup so that they would stay protected from possible sicknesses.

➤ **Workshop on Swacchata:**

The two programme officers attended the "Workshop on Swacchata" on 27<sup>th</sup>, March, 2021 organized by the State NSS cell, Govt. of Manipur at Youth Hostel Khuman Lampak, Imphal.

➤ **International Day of Yoga, 2021:**

One programme officer and 5 volunteers participated in the "Yoga for Unity and Well-being", 100 days of Yoga program, March 14 to June 21 towards the International Day of Yoga 2021.

➤ **Cleaning, Beautifying and Plantation :**

Social work programme on Cleaning, Beautification work for collecting variety of

flowers and plants and Plantation of trees at the college campus was organized on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 in collaboration with the Environmental and Eco club. In this programme 20 male and 20 female volunteers with the POs participated along with the faculty staffs.

➤ **Substance addiction awareness program:**

Drug addiction and substance abuse awareness program were organized by the unit and in collaboration with the District administration, Churachandpur on 19<sup>th</sup>, February, 2021 in the campus. 70 volunteers attended this awareness program. This program was conducted to create awareness about the danger of substance addiction, its causal factors, and what preventive measures could be taken up especially for the young college going students.

➤ **World Water Day:**

The NSS unit in collaboration with the NCC of Rayburn College organized the Observation of World Water Day on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2021 to focus on the importance of water in our daily life and to live a sustainable life. Unit II PO Ms. Mercy Chingnunhoih brief the students on daily attitudes and practices that contribute to saving water. A Poster making on Save Water was conducted with students on the importance of good hygiene, sanitation and conservation of water.

## INTRODUCTION

A field trip was conducted to gain first-hand knowledge from the classroom to a factory, farm, geological area, or environment of certain plant species (<https://www.merriam-webster.com>). A one-day field trip was taken to Thangching Herbals Enterprises, Bungmual, Forest Pick, Chengkongpang and Aichin park at Mata village, Churachadnpur Manipur. Essential oil from lemon grass is commonly used as a fragrance in perfumes and cosmetics, such as creams and soaps. (Wifek *et al.*, 2016). In Thangching Herbals Enterprises, lemon grass was extracted from the plant *Cymbopogon flexuosus* for various purposes, including room freshener, tea leaves, phenyl, medicine (to regulate blood pressure, asthma), essential oil and incense stick. Tea is the most common beverage consumed after water. Tea is found to be antimicrobial, antioxidant, anti-inflammatory and anti-carcinogenic, which has beneficial effects on human health (Soni *et al.*, 2015). One significant tea leaf production in Lamka town is the Forest Pick factory. The tea leaves produced from this include green tea leaves, black tea leaves, smoke tea leaves, wild galangal black tea leaves, flavoured tea leaves, wild tea leaves, white tea leaves and oolong tea leaves, which are plucked in the wild forest of Thanlon Sub-Division, Churachandpur, Manipur. The herbarium is linked to many fields of study, including morphology, taxonomy, ethnobotany, pharmacology, biochemistry, cytology, genetics, molecular biology, material science, ecology, conservation, plant pathology, plant breeding and physiology. This report is the outcome of our field trip to Thangching Herbals Enterprises, Forest Pick factory and Aichin Park.

The primary objectives of the field trip was to study the process of extraction of lemon grass essential oil and their by-products, document the different varieties of tea leaves processing, study plant diversity and collect the plant's specimen for the Herbarium.

## MATERIALS AND METHODS:

An Internal Field trip was conducted by the Department of Botany, Rayburn College (B.Sc. 2nd Semester) on 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 to Thangching Herbals Enterprises in Bungmual Village, Forest Pick in Chiengkonpang, Aichin Park in Mata Village of Churachandpur district Manipur. This tour was solely organized by the students themselves; they had to start from scratch. A couple of students worked together on how to turn these visions and objectives into a reality. With shared ideas and agreeing to disagree at times, taking majority votes, starting various fundraises around town and working hard to meet the required budget while at the same time balancing their academic duties, the required budget was met and with a little more contribution from themselves, their efforts had finally paid off.



On 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, at around 7:00 am in the morning, with prayers and blessings from the principal of the college, Rev. Khenpi Tombing, a total of 30 students started off our journey to Shillong from Rayburn College, Gangpimual on a hired tourist bus. We arrived Sekmai, Manipur at 10:30 am and had a 45 minutes stop there for morning food and washing up.



The journey was rather smooth without any external hindrances. When we arrived Nagaland, we had a quick stop there for lunch and freshening up and set off for our journey once again. The entire journey felt like a road trip and as tired and drained as we were, it was worth the exhaustion. At around 10:00 pm, for our last stop before Shillong, we had a 45 minutes stop at Jakhalabandha, Assam for dinner. And by 3:15 am, we had finally arrived at our destination, Shillong Bus Terminal.





**Day 1 (14<sup>th</sup> July, 2022)**: Since we arrived pretty early in the morning, we had to wait for a while for our pick-up bus which would drop us to our boarding and lodging place, the youth hostel. We arrived the youth hostel at around 5:00 am, washed up, some of us slept, some went out for a walk and by afternoon, some of us went out for movies and the rest went out exploring the market.



**Day 2 (15<sup>th</sup> July, 2022)**: We hired another tour bus in Shillong, which picked us up around 7:00 am in the morning for touring through the city and visit sites.



Our first destination for the day was the Living Root Bridge and on the way, we stopped by for some pictures and take a quick look at the mesmerizing terrain of the hills surrounding the city of Shillong.



The journey to the Living Root Bridge took a couple hours of travelling by bus and when we arrived, the place greeted us with various traditional stalls that sell handmade goods all made from wood and bamboo. The way to the bridge required a little trek and we made it there. Everyone was astounded by how roots can build an entire bridge that enables people to cross over. We had photo sessions by the river while some of us took it all in and enjoyed the beauty of the place.



For our next destination, we were headed to Mawlynnong, Discover India Magazine’s awarded “the cleanest village in Asia”. To everyone’s surprise, the place was actually really clean and lively, and we were all motivated and inspired greatly by how well the place is preserved and taken care of.



The final destination for the day was Dawki river. This site is located at the Indo-Bangladesh border, and the journey was long and pretty exhausting but for the few of us who took the boat ride, it was more worth the exhaustion than those who only just saw the river. We were told the river was not at its clearest state and when it was at its clearest, you could see the bottom of the river and boats on the river look as if they were floating.









**Day 3 (16<sup>th</sup> July, 2022):** On the third day of our stay, we decided to visit and explore the NEHU campus and their library. The students over there guided us and were open to any doubts we might want to clear up about the place or about life and career in general. We had a really productive time there.



The second place we visited on the third day was the Laitlum Canyon Ridge. The place was beyond whatever we expected it to be. It was beautiful, captivating and cold, filled with fog, valleys of grass and rocks to add volume to its beauty. When the fog cleared up, the sun came peeking out of the clouds glistening upon the dewdrops on the grass. Everyone felt a sense of relief, joy and satisfaction the moment we reached the Laitlum Canyon, and we couldn't have asked for a better experience.





**Day 4 & 5 (17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2022):** The next two days we intentionally stayed in the hostel to just enjoy our own leisure time and have some quality time among ourselves. Some of us rested, some went out for shopping, some just wanted to explore the city and the market and some went out to visit friends and relatives.

This was a great time to reflect upon ourselves and how we have spent the past few months working towards this and how we actually did it. It taught us the value of friendship and how much we can achieve

when we work together and have mutual respect for one another.



**Day 6 (19<sup>th</sup> July, 2022):** We had a great time the previous night since it was “the last night” and made lots of memories. Some early birds had the time to go shopping in the morning since our bus was supposed to leave at 2:00 pm. We packed up and our pick-up bus arrived at 12:00 pm, dropped us off at the bus terminal and from there we got in the bus and came back. By God’s grace, we had no unusual triggering encounters. The journey back was calm and quiet, everyone feeling accomplished but moody and sad at the same time because we just had the time of our lives and now it’s over. We reached the college campus at around 2:00 pm the next day, i.e. 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, reported to the principal and went home.

The whole experience was one memory we will cherish for the rest of our lives and that is worth all the frustrations and exhaustions we had to hustle through.
