

It was formed in the year 2019 and registered under Section 7(1) of the Manipur Societies Registration Act, 1989 bearing Registration No. 28 of 2021-CCp on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021. The College is proud of having an alumni association formed by past students of the college, most of whom are now serving somewhere holding prestigious posts. With zeal to render whatever support- moral or physical, cash or kind to the college and wherever opportunity comes or situation demands, ex-students of the college constituted a body entitled “Rayburn College Alumni Association (RBCAA)”. The association also encourages a sense of belonging by opening a portal for friends and colleagues to keep in touch. Admission to the association is done with a sum of ₹300/- only as Life Time Membership fee to any ex-students of the college. The association also welcome anyone willing to donate for the overall development of the college as well as to help the marginalize students of the college. The association presently is administered by an executive body of 8 (eight) members and the Principal as the Adviser for smooth functioning of the association.
